<sup>6</sup> Emma spent extra time handling COVID-19 related issues (such as attending extra Forskarutbildningsutskott -meetings and constructing and distributing a survey gathering input from doctoral students at KTH), hence the number is slightly higher than the prognosis for VT20. In HT20 she was elected to national body SFS-DK. Her HT20 time compensation exceeds the prognosis because of her election to Kårfullmäktige.

Her HT20 time compensation exceeds the prognosis due to extra load in the eISP focus group, communication, and council-related errands.


## Background

This decision should be considered with reference to the rector's decision Dnr. [V-2016-0451](#) regarding time compensation policy for doctoral students that are representatives at the KTH central level or national level. According to Dnr. V-2016-0451, THS has at its disposal the equivalent of two full-time (2 X 100%) doctoral positions per calendar year for KTH central level and national level doctoral student representatives. This document presents the time compensation for KTH central level and national level doctoral student representatives for the full calendar year of 2020, hence the inclusion of both the VT20 and HT20 hours. The time compensation for VT20 was previously communicated via [Dr2020-CP-02/001](#). The hours that are stated in this decision for HT20 should be considered as the reported and spent hours and replace the prognosis which has previously been reported in [Dr2020-PB-07\\_0001](#) and [Dr2020-CP-06/EM01](#).
