Setting a time limit for nominations for elections

Background

As per the working directives, the Nomination Committee (hereafter abbreviated as NC) at the Doktorandsektionen vid Tekniska Högskolans Studentkår is empowered and is responsible for for preparing and administering election errands for vacancies appointed by the chapter meeting with the following scope of work:

- to promote the elections that are administered during the current year of operation.
- to collect nominations and candidacies
- to interview candidates and verify the candidates' references
- to declare statements and reports about the candidates before the chapter meeting.
- to liaison with THS nominating committee for election of union vacancies

The PhD Chapter usually has elections in June and December every year to fill the board positions required for proper functioning of the board and the chapter. Usually the Chapter Meetings are announced and the deadlines are set by the Chapter Board without consultation with the NC. For example, the meeting this semester is scheduled for 20th June, and the nominations were closed by the Chapter Board on 10th June (Saturday 23:59, with 4 nominations made at the EoD), merely 6 working days before the Chapter Meeting. This gives the NC one working day to finish all the errands. Accounting for the fact that NC report is due 5 working days before the elections to the Board, and it needs to be made public at least 4 working days, it leaves almost no time for the NC to evaluate the candidatures with proper interviews. Such limited time affects the proper vetting of the candidates that the NC is responsible for, and is a disservice to the PhD Chapter to large.

As a result, I propose the following amendment to the PhD Chapter Statutes which provides the NC with a time of 5 working days after the close of nominations to interview the candidates and write a report which would be useful for the PhD Chapter to study before the elections and enable the election of the most suitable candidates.

In case there are elections, the nominations should close 10 working days before the meeting and the nomination committee report should be made public the same way, at least four working days before the meeting.
